

# CAMPUS SECURITY OFFICER COURSE

The Campus Security Officer Course was developed by The Wright Group, Inc. to assist School Districts with meeting the mandated 24 hour Campus Security Officer Training Course per Education Code 38001.5 and 72330.5.

The course is conducted over a three day period. Attendees are provided a Course Manual and will be required to pass with 100% on the final **open book** exam. Attendees who pass the course will be provided with a Certificate of Completion.

The on-site (held at your location) course can be tailored to your School/District's current policies, procedures and regulations which you provide to The Wright Group to be incorporated into the training manuals.

## COURSE INFORMATION

### Session 1

#### Role and Responsibility of School

Security Officers—the officer will be provided with an understanding of history/development of campus security, the security officer's authority both on and off duty, campus responsibilities, school structure and organization and professionalism.

Security Awareness in the Educational Environment—the officer will be provided with an understanding of the unique circumstances that exist in a school environment and an awareness of: potential dangerous situations, trespassers, visitor control and time frames for student breaks, etc..

Disasters and Emergencies—the officer will understand the District's responsibilities for managing disasters and emergencies.

### Session 2

Laws and Liability—the officers training will include: search and seizure procedures, concepts of Loco Parentis and Parens Patria, student discipline process, school's legal process and exposure, campus crimes, recognize violations and their classifications, report writing, liability issues on and off campus and privacy issues as they relate to student records.

### Session 3

Mediation and Conflict Resolution—the officer will understand the importance and techniques for utilizing Mediation/Conflict Resolution skills.

Dynamics of Student Behavior—the officer will be trained to recognize major personality disorders that are responsible for potential violent outbreaks and learn the procedure to address such violent outbreaks.

Parking and Traffic Control—the officer will be trained on directing campus traffic, campus parking enforcement, offenses and regulations.
